<b>Product dimension</b>	Belmont Clothes Library is an innovative concept that allows unemployed people to borrow clothes for job interviews as they would books from a library. The service is free for eligible people such as unemployed people, high school students, University or TAFE students, and is located in Belmont, Western Australia. Over 1500 fashion garments have been donated from leading Western Australian designers, clothing manufacturers, and the public for use in the library. The clothes library has full range of sizes in women's and men's garments.
<b>Service dimension</b>	Belmont Clothes Library is entirely staffed by volunteers and is open between 10am and 2pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Clothes can be borrowed throughout the working hours or by calling for an appointment. The library volunteers offer assistance in choosing the most suitable clothes. In some cases, the library can help with hair cuts, make-up and accessories.
